

Executive Summary

In the process of drafting the National Development Strategy, the thematic area Rule of Law and Fight against Corruption is important. The existence of a society with rule of law, where laws are enforced efficiently and transparently, and where there are clearly defined mechanisms for preventing corruption is a prerequisite for the development of other areas.

This document will analyze the strategic documents related to the rule of law and the fight against corruption. State institutions as well as other stakeholders who are holders of these strategic documents as well as those to whom these documents refer will be mapped. The conclusions from the monitoring reports of these strategic documents, which have been prepared by state institutions, civil society organizations and international bodies, will be analyzed separately.

During the analysis of the strategic documents, the laws to which they refer will be mapped and through whose amendments the successful implementation of these strategies is expected. The key activities mentioned in these strategic documents will be analyzed. The manner of adopting strategies in this area in the context of multidisciplinary issues, cross-sectoral approach, the inclusiveness of the process of their adoption, the availability of indicators, monitoring mechanisms and the relationship with other strategic documents will be also analyzed.

The purpose of this document is to map the key strategic documents in the area of rule of law and fight against corruption, to map key stakeholders as well as a brief overview of the legislation in this area.

At the end of the analysis, appropriate conclusions and recommendations will be given on how these documents can be used in the process of preparing a comprehensive National Development Strategy.
